NATIONAL SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON CAMPUS JOURNALISM

The Association of Educators for Interrelated Research and Studies (AEIRS) will conduct a National Seminar-Workshop on Campus Journalism with the theme "*The School Paper Governance in the 21st Century: A Catalyst for a Social Change*" from September 30 to October 2, 2010 at the Teachers Camp, Baguio City.

The seminar aims to:

- a. encourage campus reporters to conduct further investigation on school problems and issues;
- b. train them to become more responsible writers;
- c. promote the function of the newspaper and its importance to the public;
- d. identify the limitations of writers and their effect when abused; and
- e. orient the participants on how to write articles of different types.

The participants to this activity are teachers handling journalism subjects or acting advisers of school publications, supervisors, principals, head teachers, editors-in-chief or staffers of a school paper and other interested students.

A registration fee of Two Thousand Pesos (PhP2,000.00) will be charged each participant, inclusive of certificates, handouts, lunch and snacks only. The organizer will assist the participants for their lodging.
