CHANGES IN DEPED MEMORANDUM NO. 53, S. 2010
(Guidelines on Strengthening the Special Education Program at the Elementary Level)

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public Elementary Schools

1. To strengthen the implementation of the Special Education (SPED) Program at the elementary level, the operation of 227 existing SPED Centers shall be supported through the provision of financial subsidy with an aggregate amount of One Hundred Thirteen Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php113.5 M). The breakdown of financial subsidy per region and center is computed on the basis of enrolment of children with special needs as reported in the BEIS School Year (SY) 2009 which is enclosed.

2. Thus, Paragraph No. 1 and guideline No. 1 of DepEd Memorandum No. 53, s. 2010 is hereby changed and should be read as follows:

“ . . . the operation of 230 recognized SPED Centers shall be supported through the provision of financial subsidy with an aggregate amount of One Hundred Thirteen Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php113.5M) among others. Enclosure No. 1 shows the number of regions, divisions and SPED Centers as reported in the Division List of Recognized Special Education (SPED) Centers.

1. The said amount of financial subsidy shall be used specifically for the activities of the SPED Centers as reflected in their approved School Improvement Plan (SIP), such as:

- ***Professional upgrading of teachers and administrators in Special and Inclusive Education as well as availing the services of Allied Health Personnel, namely:***

- ***Occupational Therapist;***
- ***Physical Therapist;***
- ***Speech Therapist;***
- ***Behavioral Therapist; and***
- ***Psychologist.***

- ***Procurement of supplies and materials for work centers/transition program”.***

3. All other provisions in the aforementioned Memorandum shall remain the same.

4. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
