





**WHOLE SCHOOL APPROACH (WSA) TO MASTERY READING AND WRITING
FOR SUCCESSFUL LEARNING IN PRIVATE SECONDARY SCHOOLS**

To: Bureau Directors

1. The National Association of Secondary Schools of the Philippines (NASSPHIL), in coordination with the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) will hold the *Training-Workshop on Whole School Approach (WSA) to Mastery Reading and Writing for Successful Learning in Private Secondary Schools* on August 6-8, 2010 at the Bacolod Pavilion Hotel and Resort, Bacolod City.
2. The training-workshop aims to build the capacity of the private schools to adopt a systemwide approach to reading and writing development.
3. The participants to this training-workshop are teachers of the following subject areas: *English, Mathematics, Science, Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE)* and *Music, Arts, Physical Education and Health (MAPEH)* from private secondary schools. Each participant is requested to bring laptop, extension cord and a Globe/Smart broadband.
4. A registration fee of Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP3,500.00) shall be charged each participant to cover the costs of board and lodging, handouts and other incidental expenses. Traveling expenses and registration fee shall be charged to school funds.
5. Registration starts at 1:00 p.m. and the Opening Program at 3:00 p.m. on August 6. The first meal will be afternoon snacks on August 6 and the last meal will be lunch on August 8, 2010.
