4TH NATIONAL MDGs SUMMIT FOR YOUNG LEADERS

The Youth Advocates for United Nations (YAUN) formerly the United Nations Youth Association of the Philippines (UNYAP), a proud member of the Global Youth Action Network (GYAN), in collaboration with the United Nations Population Fund-Youth Advisory Panel (UNFPA-YAP) and AIESEC Philippines-Ateneo de Manila University will conduct the 4th National Millenium Development Goals (MDGs) Summit for Young Leaders 2010 in Quezon City on May 27-29, 2010 with the theme **“Tayo-Tayo Pa Rin sa 2015” (Still Together in 2015)**.
