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INTENSIVE TRAINING COURSE ON ASSESSMENT OF NUTRITIONAL STATUS BY THE
DEPARTMENT OF NUTRITION, COLLEGE OF PUBLIC HEALTH,
UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES MANILA

The Department of Nutrition, College of Public Health, University of the Philippines (UP) Manila will hold the Intensive Training Course on Assessment of Nutritional Status from April 16 to 20, 2018 at the Press Room Annex II Building, College of Public Health, University of the Philippines Manila.

The course aims to:

1. enhance the decision-making skills of health professionals by providing them with an overview of the common nutrition assessment tools and issues related to its use;
2. expose them to selected technology used in the field and laboratory to assess nutritional status; and
3. reinforce their learning with updates on NSA with emphasis on body composition, biochemical and clinical indicators related to macro- and micronutrient deficiencies, alongside the practice use of dietary assessment methods and tools to assess individual food intake.

The target participants are nutritionist-dietitians, public health nutritionists (nutrition officers, provincial nutrition action officers, city nutrition action officers, municipal nutrition action officers), nutrition educators, nutrition and allied health professionals (faculty and researchers), medical doctors, wellness counselors, and graduate students of nutrition.

Participation of both public and private schools shall be subject to the no-disruption-of-classes policy stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith.

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
