(BIOTA Philippines Inc.) will conduct its *52nd Annual National Convention and Scientific Sessions* with the theme *Biology Education in Unifying ASEAN Countries* from April 6 to 8, 2017 at the Philippine Normal University, Taft Avenue, Manila.
