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CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FOR THE FUTURE ACHIEVERS
INTERNATIONAL PROGRAM

The Faculty of Social Sciences of the University of the University of Ottawa is now accepting applications for the Future Achievers International (FAI) Program—a spin-off from the Canadian Future Achievers (CFA) Program which recognizes and provides financial awards to academically strong and community-involved youth.

This Program aims to provide positive reinforcement for Future Achievers, encourage them to maintain high expectations for themselves, complete their high school, and master their post-secondary studies.

The nominations for the Winter 2017 Round is open. The scholarship is open to the following students:

1. Between ages 9 and 16;
2. Have a minimum academic average of A;
3. Have demonstrated commitment to and engagement in extracurricular activities; and
4. Recognized by their teachers as capable of acting as a role model among peers.

The following are the awards for the Future Achievers:

Year	Award
In their first year	A monetary gift of \$250 and a welcoming package
In subsequent years of involvement, annually, and until their high school graduation	A monetary gift of \$250 and a FAI certificate of recognition
Upon graduating from high school	A \$1500 scholarship to the post-secondary institution of their choice (if the recipient has been involved in the program for three years prior to graduation)

Interested applicants may send the following requirements on or before *April 21, 2017* to the International Cooperation Office, G/F Teodora Alonzo Bldg., Department of Education Central Office, DepEd Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City:

1. Duly accomplished Application Form;
2. List of awards received by the student (academic or other, with supporting documents);
3. List of activities in which the student plays a leadership role (with supporting documents);
4. Recommendation letter from the School Principal stating reasons why the student is identified as a role model; and
5. Statement by the student as to why he/she wishes to be a member of FAI.
