The Science Club Advisers Association of the Philippines (SCAAP) Inc., will conduct the *National Science Club Month (NSCM) Celebration Seminar/Workshop* with the theme *Enhancing Project Management Through Research Skills and Conducting Science Investigations* from September 27 to 30, 2017 at the Subic Bay Travelers Hotel and Events Center.

The Seminar-Workshop aims to:

1. enhance the participants' ideas on project management through science investigations;
2. help them apply the key elements of project management;
3. enable them to understand fully the types of project management;
4. develop managerial skills that every project manager needs;
5. provide them with effective medium in conducting science investigations;
6. upgrade their skills on writing a project proposal employing the new IMRAD format; and
7. promote and transfer Science and Technology at the grass roots level.

The target participants are the science club advisers, science supervisors, department heads, science coordinators, science teachers, trainers and coaches of science congress from both public and private elementary and secondary schools.
