SEMINAR-WORKSHOP FOR RIZAL'S IDEAS ON CITIZENSHIP  
IN *NOLI ME TANGERE* AND *EL FILIBUSTERISMO*

The University of Asia and the Pacific (UA&P) will conduct the Seminar-Workshop for Rizal's Ideas on Citizenship in *Noli Me Tangere* and *El Filibusterismo* from April 25 to 27, 2018 at the Telengtán Hall, ACB, University of Asia and the Pacific, Pasig City.

The Seminar-Workshop aims to:

1. develop correct and deeper understanding of the historical background of Rizal's novels in order for high school teachers to have strong and integral understanding of historical concepts, themes, and issues in history and historiography;
2. demonstrate some of the best practices in teaching approaches and assessment tools used in these subjects; and
3. illustrate how the learners can use critical analysis, academic reasoning, and practice responsible citizenship and civic virtues.

The participants are Filipino and Social Studies teachers from both public and private schools.
