## 2018 ANNUAL CONFERENCE OF THE PHILIPPINE HISTORICAL ASSOCIATION

The Philippine Historical Association (PHA) will conduct the 2018 Annual Conference with the theme Bridging the Gap: The Role of Academic and Public History in Shaping the Nation from September 20 to 22, 2018 at the GSIS *Museo ng Sining*, Diosdado Macapagal Avenue, Pasay City (Days 1 and 2) and the National Museum of Natural History (Day 3), City of Manila.

The conference aims to:

1. determine the state of Public History in the Philippines;
2. identify trends in the development of public history;
3. recognize Filipino historians and other scholars doing research on public history;
4. serve as an outlet of cutting edge historical research;
5. enrich historical education;
6. provide a venue for collaboration and networking between the academe and various industries; and
7. make historical research relevant to contemporary needs.
