AUTHORITY TO OFFER THE BACHELOR OF SECONDARY EDUCATION
AND THE BACHELOR OF ELEMENTARY EDUCATION COURSES AT
THE SURIGAO DEL NORTE SCHOOL OF ARTS AND TRADES

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents

1. Upon the recommendation of DECS Region X Office, Cagayan de Oro City, and the Bureau of Higher Education, Surigao del Norte School of Arts and Trades in Surigao City is hereby authorized to operate the Bachelor of Secondary Education (BSED) major in Industrial Arts and the Bachelor of Elementary Education (BEED) major in Work Education courses, in lieu of the Bachelor of Science in Industrial Education (BSIED) course beginning SY 1989-90.
2. This authority is issued as a special case, provided, that the Bachelor of Science in Industrial Education course presently offered by the school be gradually phased out beginning SY 1989-90; and provided further that budgetary requirements for the operation of the herein approved courses be appropriated and maintained.
3. In case of failure on the part of above-named school to observe and maintain any of the required standards of the Department of Education, Culture and Sports affecting said courses and to provide appropriation to support the same, the authority hereby granted may be revoked and cancelled.

OPERATIONALIZATION OF THE RP-EEC AGRICULTURE
EDUCATION DEVELOPMENT PROJECT (AGRED)

To: Undersecretaries

1. In line with the thrust to upgrade and rationalize agricultural education and training through the establishment and maintenance of the National Agriculture Education System (NAES), the RP-EEC Agriculture Education Development Project (RP-EEC AGRED) is hereby operationalized.

2. The Project, supported by a grant from the European Economic Community (EEC), will develop five (5) selected agriculture institutions into Provincial Technical Institutes of Agriculture (PTIAs) and be provided with a comprehensive program of improvements in: (i) their physical facilities, staff skills and operational capabilities; (ii) agricultural and teacher training curricula; and (iii) outreach activities particularly in the areas of adult education, farmer training and agrarian reform. The five institutions are:

- a. Abra State Institute of Science and Technology (ASIST)
Lagangilang, Abra
- b. Ifugao State College of Agriculture and Forestry (ISCAF)
Lamut, Ifugao
- c. Aurora National Agricultural School (ANAS)
San Joaquin, Maria Aurora
Aurora Province
- d. Antique College of Agriculture (ACA)
Hantik, Antique

- e. Misamis Oriental State College of
Agriculture and Technology (MOSCAT)
Claveria, Misamis Oriental

3. In conformity with the Financing Memorandum (ALA/PHI/8824) between the Commission of the European Communities and the Government of the Philippines, implementation of the Project shall be the responsibility of the Educational Development Projects Implementing Task Force (EDPITAF). Dr. Victor M. Ordóñez, Undersecretary for Foreign-Assisted Projects and EDPITAF Executive Director, is hereby designated as Project Director responsible for project planning and implementation.

4. For efficient and effective implementation of the Project, there is hereby created a Project Management Office (PMO) responsible for the project operation and its day-to-day management. Ms. Elizabeth S. Fontanoza shall serve as the Project Manager. The other managerial, technical and support staff necessary, including the consultants, shall be appointed by the Project Director.

5. All DECS rules, regulations and other issuances or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with this Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
