#### NATIONAL SEARCH FOR THE MOST OUTSTANDING BASIC LITERACY MOBILE TEACHER

- 1. The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Nonformal Education (BNFE), announces the National Search for the Most Outstanding Basic Literacy Mobile Teacher.
- 2. The Search seeks to give due honor to the Basic Literacy Mobile Teacher as a noble professional by recognizing his/her exemplary performance, dedication and outstanding achievements in the promotion of literacy among the deprived, depressed and underserved populace.
- 3. The Regional Office shall constitute a Regional Search Committee which will select the Regional Most Outstanding Basic Literacy Mobile Teacher who will, in turn, be chosen from among the division nominees. (See Enclosures, Guidelines and Procedures)
- 4. The Regional Most Outstanding Basic Literacy Mobile Teacher winner will receive a Plaque of Recognition and a cash gift of Five Thousand Pesos (PhP5,000.00) during the Regional Literacy Week Celebration on the first week of September.
- 5. The expenses incurred in the conduct of the Regional Search (inclusive of the travel expenses of the winner from the Division Office to the Regional Office) will be charged against the BNFE funds in the amount of Eleven Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP11,500.00) through fund transfer to the region. Liquidation should be submitted to the Accounting Division, DepEd, copy furnished the BNFE, one week after the awarding rites.
- 6. The Regional Office is expected to nominate the regional winner to the BNFE who will shortlist the 16 regional winner-nominees to five (5) contenders for the National Search.
- 7. Each regional winner nominated for the National Search is required to submit the duly accomplished nomination form with the supporting documents specified in the Requirements and Criteria for the National Search, in triplicate copy. (See Enclosures and Checklist)

- 8. The Central Office will form a National Search Committee (NSC) composed of three (3) NFE evaluators and a search coordinator who will be tasked to evaluate the five (5 short listed national nominees.
- 9. The National Search Evaluation process will include documentary analyses of pertinent records, on-site observations of and interviews with the nominees, learners and other concerned stakeholders (e.g., the barangay leaders, residents of the communities served, key DepEd officials and significant others).
- 10. The Evaluation Criteria will cover the following items:
  - I. Potential 40% (Personality and Character (10%), Job Competence (20%) Professional Growth (10%)
  - II. Achievements 60% (Work Achievements (20%), Impact on the Learners (20%), and Community Development (20%) (See Enclosures, Evaluation Form)
- 11. The National Most Outstanding Basic Literacy Mobile Teacher will receive a Plaque of Recognition and a cash gift in the amount of Twenty Thousand Pesos (PhP20,000.00), Fifteen Thousand Pesos (PhP15,000.00) for the Second Place and Ten Thousand Pesos (PhP10,000.00) for the Third Place during the celebration of the Education Week in December.
- 12. Travel and accommodation expenses of the national winners from the region for the national awards will be charged against BNFE funds.
- 13. All expenses relative to the conduct of the abovestated activities are subject to the usual government auditing and accounting rules and regulations.
- 14. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.

# GUIDELINES ON THE NOMINATION AND SELECTION OF THE NATIONAL SEARCH FOR THE MOST OUTSTANDING BASIC LITERACY MOBILE TEACHER

#### A. Nomination Procedures

- 1. The candidate for the Regional Award will be nominated by the Schools Division Superintendent based on the recommendation of the Division NFE Supervisor, District NFE Coordinator and the Principal/School Head in charge of the Basic Literacy Mobile Teacher. All nomination forms with supporting documents will be submitted to the Regional Director, Attention the NFED Chief, on or before the end of February of the year.
- 2. The Regional Winner who becomes the candidate for the National Search is expected to be officially nominated by the Regional Director to the BNFE with a Letter of Endorsement accompanying the completely filled nomination form and the required supporting documents.

#### B. Requirements

- 1. For the Regional Search, the duly accomplished Nomination Form certified/endorsed by the reputable persons representing various levels, namely: the School Principal, the NFE Division Supervisor and the Schools Division Superintendent.
- 2. For the National Search, the same documents as in No. 1 with a letter of Endorsement from the Regional Director and a picture of the Regional winner-nominee during the awarding rites.
- 3. Supporting documents specified in the Checklist. (See Enclosure No. 3)
- 4. The Regional Search nominee's documents/papers will be sent to the Regional Director, Attention NFED Chief on or before the 4<sup>th</sup> week of September of the year.
- 5. The National Search nominee's documents for the Most Outstanding Basic Literacy Mobile Teacher should be sent before the end of September of the year to:

#### C. Selection Procedures

- 1. The Regional Search Committee will be composed of the Regional Director or Assistant Director as Chairman, the NFED Chief as Co-chair and the Regional NFE Supervisor in-charge of the Basic Literacy Mobile Program as member.
- 2. Short listing will be done by the Basic Literacy Mobile Program Project Team from the 16 Regional winners-nominees to 5 contenders for the National Search...
- 3. A National Search Committee (NSC) composed of the BNFE Coordinator and three selected NFE Evaluators will review the records of the sixteen winner-nominees based on the criteria prepared to confirm the validity of the 5 contenders.
- 4. The National Search Committee will closely evaluate the 5 contenders with the conduct of documentary analyses, panel interviews and observations on site.
- 5. After thorough deliberations, the first, second and third place national winners will be decided upon. The decision of the National Search Committee is final and executory.

#### D. Awards and Related Expenses

The BNFE fund assistance for the project is expected to be disbursed in accordance with the Budgetary Allocation for the National Search for Most Outstanding Basic Literacy Mobile Teacher for the year. (See Enclosure Nos. 4 & 5)
