**NATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM FOR SCHOOL PAPER ADVISERS**

TO: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Division/City Superintendents

1. Pursuant to the provisions of RA 7079, otherwise known as the Campus Journalism Act of 1991, mandating the Department of Education to provide training programs/seminars for teacher-advisers, the National Training Program for School Paper Advisers shall be held at Teachers Camp, Baguio City on **May 10-12, 2003**.
2. The theme of this year's training program is **"Expanding the Reach of Campus Journalism Through Information and Communication Technology"**, which was also the theme of the 2003 NSPC held in the cities of Lapu Lapu and Mandaue.
3. The training program aims to:
  - a. Equip school paper advisers with the necessary skills in radio scriptwriting and broadcasting;
  - b. Develop a 5-year training program for school paper adviser; and
  - c. Prepare the participants for the delivery of a 5-minute news segment and simulation of a radio broadcast.
4. The participants to this training program are:
  - a. 15 elementary and 15 secondary teacher-advisers each from Regions III, V, VI and NCR, and 10 elementary and 10 secondary teacher-advisers from each of all the other regions. The Regional Office, in coordination with the Regional (Elementary/Secondary) School Paper Advisers Associations, shall select the teacher-advisers.
  - b. 9 Officers of the NSSPAA
  - c. 9 Officers of the PAESPA
  - d. 1 Regional Supervisor per region
5. Participants shall be accommodated starting **May 10**. The first meal to be served will be **breakfast of May 10**, while the last meal will be **dinner of May 12**. ☞


6. Teacher advisers and regional supervisors in-charge of journalism shall pay a registration fee of **Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00) and One Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (P1,800)**, respectively. Travelling expenses and registration fee shall be charged against local/school funds subject to availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

7. The travelling expenses of the members of the Working Committees, facilitators, speakers/resources persons to and from Baguio City, board and lodging of all participants, workshop materials and honoraria shall be charged against the Campus Journalism funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

8. The guidelines (Annex 1) to be considered in the selection of participants, the Working Committees (Annex 2) composed of the BSE, BEE and NSSPAA/PAESPA, the names (Annex 3) of the National Secondary School Paper Advisers Association (NSSPAA) and the Philippine Association of Elementary School Paper Advisers (PAESPA) are appended.

9. The Regional Directors through the Regional Supervisors, in coordination with the Presidents of the Regional Association of School Paper Advisers are advised to submit to BSE a definite schedule and venue of the training program in their respective regions. The information shall be appended to the **DECS MEMORANDUM** announcing the schedule of Regional Training Programs for School Paper Advisers, to be issued immediately after the National Training Program for School Paper Advisers.

10. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
