**SECONDARY EDUCATION DIVISION CHIEFS AND ASSISTANT CHIEFS NATIONAL  
CONSULTATIVE CONFERENCE AND PLANNING WORKSHOP**

To: Regional Directors

1. The Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) in collaboration with the Philippine Association of Secondary Education Division Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs shall conduct a National Consultative Conference and Planning Workshop on Education for all (EFA) Plan at the secondary level on July 7-10, 2003 at the Camelot Hotel, 35 Mother Ignacia Street, Diliman, Quezon City.
2. The conference aims to:
  - a. validate the vision of the EFA Plan in basic education;
  - b. assess the situation of Plan implementation at the secondary level;
  - c. identify gaps in the implementation of the Plan; and
  - d. propose program intervention strategies at the regional and national levels.
3. The participants are the thirty-two (32) Secondary Education Division (SED) Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs, the Director III/Officer-in-Charge of BSE, the Division Chiefs/Officer-in-Charge of SDD and selected BSE staff who are involved in the EFA project.
4. A registration fee of Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP3,500.00) to cover expenses for board and lodging and materials shall be charged each participant. The regional participants' transportation and other expenses incidental to their attendance in this activity shall be charged against local funds. The BSE participants shall charge their transportation and other incidental expenses and registration expenses against BSE funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. The list of participants and the tentative schedule of activities are found in Enclosures 1 and 2, respectively. The participants are expected to check in at the hotel on Monday, July 7 at 10:00 a.m. and check out on July 10 at 10:00 a.m.
6. The participants are requested to bring with them the data/statistics on their regional performance indicators of the last three years (SY 2000-2003) and targets for the next twelve (12) years (SY 2003-2015) as basis in planning the intervention and strategies to address the need/gaps identified in the assessment. The data should be disaggregated by gender, geographical location and cultural grouping, where applicable.
