## 19th WORLD COUNCIL FOR CURRICULUM NATIONAL CONVENTION

- The World Council for Curriculum and Instruction (WCCI), a transnational educational organization committed to advancing the achievement of a just and peaceful world community, is holding its 19th National Convention on August 14-15, 2003 at the Holiday Inn, United Nations Avenue, Ermita, Manila.

- Participants to this activity are WCCI members, university/college administrators, supervisors, curriculum theorists and practitioners/teachers from the preschool, elementary, high school, tertiary, and graduate school levels of both public and private schools nationwide. A registration fee of Three Thousand Pesos (PhP3,000.00) will be charged each participant to cover expenses for two lunch meals, four snacks, conference kits, hotel services and other operational expenses. ←
