NATIONAL CONVENTION

1. The World Council for Curriculum and Instruction (WCCI), a transnational educational organization committed to advancing the achievement of a just and peaceful world community, is holding its 19<sup>th</sup> National Convention on August 14-15, 2003 at the Holiday Inn, United Nations Avenue, Ermita, Manila.

2. With the theme "**Closing the Academic Divide: Challenge of Integration Across the Curriculum for Responsible Citizenship in a Global Society,**" the convention aims to:

- a. facilitate national and international dialogue on key issues of Education e.g. peace, environmental challenges, human rights, information technology, gender sensitivity, multicultural/crosscultural education among others;
- b. share and demonstrate successful innovations in curriculum and instructional materials responsive to the varied needs of the learners in all levels and programs;
- c. promote active involvement of participants in the activities and projects of the varied Commissions – Early Childhood, Elementary, Secondary, Tertiary and Graduate levels, and Vocational/Technical and Special Education; and
- d. strengthen networking on the local, national and international levels for curriculum programs and designs to meet the challenges of the 21<sup>st</sup> century.

3. Participants to this activity are WCCI members, university/college administrators, supervisors, curriculum theorists and practitioners/teachers from the preschool, elementary, high school, tertiary, and graduate school levels of both public and private schools nationwide. A registration fee of Three Thousand Pesos (PhP3,000.00) will be charged each participant to cover expenses for two lunch meals, four snacks, conference kits, hotel services and other operational expenses. ↶

4. Attendance to this convention shall be on official time only. Those coming from the private schools may make arrangements with their respective administrators.
