Southeast Asia Interdisciplinary Development Institute (SAIDI) and Department of Education Scholars for year 2004-2005

1. Pursuant to the objectives contained in DepEd Memorandum No. 98, s 2004 on the selection and endorsement of scholars for Masters in Instruction Development and Technology (MA ID& T) at SAIDI under the National English Proficiency Program (NEPP), the official list of 21 scholars who qualified is hereby attached. (Inclosure 1).

We extend our Congratulations to the grantee, School Heads and Principals of schools where these scholars came from.

2. The MA ID & T scholarship or otherwise known as the SUSTECH Program is an innovative, action research graduate program which runs for two summers and ten months. The first Summer classes started last May 17 and will end on June 5, 2004. During the ten months, scholars will remain to teach in their schools and implement their projects. The program has three phases namely:

Phase I – Guideposting Phase

Summer 2004, (3 weeks face to face coursework,) 1 week for English proficiency, 2 weeks for instructional development, technology and research seminar.

Phase II - Mentoring Phase

Following the first summer, a 10 month action research in the scholar's school will be supervised on line by the SAIDI faculty and monitored by DepED. The scholar will transfer technology to 10 peers, preferably teachers from the same school or neighboring school. The peers will receive a Certificate in Instruction

Development and Technology. Organization and implementation will be the scholar and principal's responsibility.

Phase III - Authoring Phase

Peers and scholar get together for a workshop on best practices and prepare a Teaching Manual Using Various Technology in Instruction Delivery.

Summer 2005, 2 weeks face to face for oral defense of school-based research and revision, finalization of the work. The Candidate will receive an MA Degree in Instruction Development and Technology. This will be held at SAIDI, Antipolo, Rizal.

- 3. The DepEd-SAIDI scholarship pays for each scholar the full tuition, board and lodging and materials, plus an assistance of five thousand pesos (P5,000) for finalizing the project paper by Summer 2005. However, the transportation cost of the scholars to go to SAIDI at Antipolo, Rizal and return to their station for the two summers' face to face sessions, is to be charged against local funds.
- 4. The School Principals or Heads are enjoined to fully support the implementation of the action research project which the scholars have formulated for implementation in their schools.
- 5. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
