DepED MEMORANDUM No 313. s. 2004

REGIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM FOR SCHOOL PAPER ADVISERS AND CAMPUS JOURNALISTS

To:

Bureau Directors Regional Directors

Schools Division/City Superintendents

- 1. Pursuant to the provision of R.A. 7079, otherwise known as the Campus Journalism Act of 1991, mandating the Department of Education to provide training programs/seminars for teacher-advisers and campus journalists (elementary and secondary levels), the Regional Training Program for School Paper Advisers, which is a follow-through of the National Training Program for School Paper Advisers held at Teachers Camp, Baguio City from May 29 to June 1, 2004, shall be conducted between August 1 and September 15, 2004.
- 2. The National Training for Campus Journalists which shall be conducted at the regional level shall be held simultaneously with the Regional Training of the School Paper Advisers. Date and venue shall be determined by the region.
- 3. The theme of this year's training program is "Redirection of Values for Nation Building through Campus Journalism." The training program generally aims to develop the basic journalistic skills of selected pupils in the elementary and secondary levels. Specifically, it aims to:
 - equip school paper advisers, students and pupils (elementary and secondary levels) with the necessary skills in radio scriptwriting and broadcasting with focus on redirecting values into righteous and ideal standards;
 - enable the school paper advisers, students and pupils to prepare a script for a five-minute news segment with preference to news that will strengthen character of the youth in the fight against emerging degeneration of moral values;
 - c. promote journalism competencies through individual and team competition focused on strengthening the character of the Filipino; and
 - d. prepare the participants for the presentation of a simulated news segment with focus on values.
- The categories to be tackled during the campus journalists' training are:
 - a. news that can be refocused on strengthening values;
 - b. editorials insinuating redirection of values;
 - c. features that will involve righteous ideals;
 - d. copyreading/headline writing focused on quality and standard of dignity;
 - e. photojournalism with emphasis on the theme; and
 - f. editorial cartoon also focused on the theme.

- 5. The participants in the training program are:
 - school paper advisers from the elementary and secondary levels in each division;
 - incoming junior editors from the elementary and secondary levels (to be determined by the Regional Office in coordination with the regional associations of school paper advisers) specifically those who will be in Grade VI and 3rd year, respectively in SY 2004 – 2005) to be chosen by the division supervisor in-charge of journalism in coordination with the Regional Office;
 - officers of the regional elementary and secondary school paper advisers associations;
 - officers of the National Elementary Editors Guild and the National Secondary Editors Guild;
 - regional supervisors in-charge of journalism (1 elementary and 1 secondary); and
 - five core trainors.
- 6. Participants to the seminar shall be determined by the division supervisors in coordination with the local division school paper advisers associations at the elementary and secondary levels. The list of participants from each division shall be submitted to the Regional Office for approval.
- 7. A minimum registration fee may be charged each campus journalist and school paper adviser depending on the scheme of the training. Traveling expenses of the participants shall be charged against local school funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 8. A subsidy of Ten Thousand Pesos per division shall be released to the DepED Regional Director upon submission of the training design to BEE not later than July 30, 2004.
- 9. Enclosed is the list of monitors and their respective assignments.
