SEAMEO-RECSAM SCHEDULE OF COURSES FOR FY 2005/2006

To: Bureau Directors

1. The Southeast Asian Ministers of Education Organization-Regional Center for Education in Science and Mathematics (SEAMEO-RECSAM) in Penang, Malaysia, in coordination with the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE), this Department, announces the regular courses for Fiscal Year 2005/2006.
2. These scholarships are extended to school teachers, supervisors and school administrators in the elementary and secondary school levels. All courses are of four (4) weeks duration and there is only one slot per course.

4. Interested applicants may send their pertinent papers through proper channels to the Secretary (Attn.: Dr. Lolita M. Andrada, Director IV, Bureau of Secondary Education). Applicants should have a degree in science or mathematics education, minimum teaching experience of at least five (5) years and must not have availed of a similar training or scholarship program in the last two years. Nominees must be in excellent health and should not be more than fifty (50) years of age. He/She must also have knowledge of basic computer application programs and good at spoken and written English in order to get the maximum benefit from the course.

5. Participants from the Philippines may also join on a fee-paying basis provided that they will abide by the stipulations of the RECSAM-Scholar Agreement, follow the requirements of the programme, are physically fit, able to meet the necessary qualification to attend the course and pay a minimum course fee which do not cover airfares, medical expenses, out-of-pocket allowances, insurance, food and extension of visa fees.



Deadline for submission of nominations together with the nominees' transcript of records, performance ratings for the last three years, latest service record, medical certificate from a government medical officer, certification of no pending administrative or criminal case, personal data sheet (CS Form 212), photocopy of baccalaureate diploma, certification of English proficiency and endorsement from the Regional Director shall be as follows:

- Batch I: April 15, 2005
- Batch II: June 15, 2005
- Batch III: December 15, 2005

7. School heads are advised to make arrangements for substitute teachers to ensure that classes of the scholarship recipients are not disrupted.
