TRAINING-WORKSHOP OF SPORTS COORDINATORS AND TEACHERS FOR THE SPECIAL PROGRAM IN SPORTS

To: Regional Directors

Schools Division/City Superintendents Heads, Public and Private Secondary Schools

- 1. In preparation for the institutionalization of the Special Program in Sports for SY 2005-2006, the Department of Education (DepED), through the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE), shall conduct a Training-Workshop of Sports Coordinators and Teachers for the Special Program in Sports (SPS) on May 16-20, 2005 at Teachers Camp, Baguio City.
- 2. The training-workshop aims to enhance the teaching as well as the coaching skills of Physical Education (P.E.) teachers in developing the talent of SPS students in different fields of sports.
- 3. Participants to the training-workshop are the sports coordinators and P.E. teachers of the schools that intend to offer the Special Program in Sports. The schools shall send one (1) participant each in the following sports: athletics, badminton, basketball, baseball/softball, football, gymnastics, lawn tennis, sepak takraw, swimming, teakwondo, table tennis, and volleyball. The training is open to both public and private secondary school teachers.
- 4. A registration fee of Four Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP4,500.00) shall be charged each participant to cover board and lodging, rental of session halls and equipment, honoraria of resource persons and speaker, training kit, transportation of participants to and from the practicum venue and other incidental expenses relative to the training-workshop. Public school teachers/sports coordinators shall charge their registration fee and traveling allowance to local funds. Traveling expenses, board and lodging and other incidental expenses of resource persons and BSE personnel shall be charged against BSE funds. All expenses are subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
