COMPUTATION OF PROPORTIONAL VACATION PAY FOR TEACHERS SCHOOL YEAR 2004-2005

To:

Regional Directors

Schools Division/City Superintendents

Heads, Public Elementary and Secondary Schools

- 1. This is to provide the field offices with a uniform basis in computing the Proportional Vacation Pay (PVP) an elementary/secondary teacher on the teachers' leave basis is entitled to for services rendered during school year 2004-2005.
- 2. Teachers who rendered continuous services for school year 2004-2005 from June 7, 2004 to April 1, 2005 (for elementary schools) and from June 21, 2004 to April 15, 2005 (for secondary schools) shall be entitled to sixty-five (65) days PVP from April 1 to June 5, 2005 (for elementary schools) and fifty-one (51) days from April 15 to June 5, 2005 (for secondary schools), computed as follows:

2.1. For Elementary Schools

Total number of days served	299 days
(June 7, 2004 to April 1, 2005	,
Less: Christmas vacation days	
(December 22, 2004 to January 2, 2005)	<u>-12 days</u>
Actual days served	287 days
Multiply factor	<u>× .268</u>
Total PVP including Christmas vacation days	
Less: Christmas Vacation	<u>-</u> 12
PVP earned from April 12 to June 5, 2005)	65 days

Derivation of factor .268

Number of summer vacation days	65 days
(April 2, 2005 to June 5, 2005)	•
Add: Number of Christmas vacation days	+12 days
Total PVP including Christmas vacation	77 days
Divided by actual days served	287 days
Factor	.268

2.2. For Secondary Schools

Total number of days served (June 21, 2004 to April 15, 2005)	299 days
Less: Christmas vacation days (December 22, 2004 to January 2, 2005) Actual days served Multiply factor Total PVP including Christmas vacation days Less: Christmas Vacation PVP earned from April 16 to June 5, 2005)	-12 days 287 days x .220 63 - 12 51 days
Derivation of factor .220	
Number of summer vacation days (April 16, 2005 to June 5, 2005)	51 days
Add: Number of Christmas vacation days Total PVP including Christmas vacation Divided by actual days served Factor	+ <u>12 days</u> 63 days <u>287 days</u> .220

- 3. Factor .268 for elementary schools and .220 for secondary schools shall be used in the computation of absences and PVP due school year 2004-2005.
