6th NATIONAL CONVENTION ON DEAF EDUCATION AND AWARDING OF THE MOST OUTSTANDING TEACHERS OF THE DEAF

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

- 1. The Department of Education through the Special Education Division of the Bureau of Elementary Education in coordination with the National Association of Special Educators and Christoffel Blindenmission (CBM) International will hold the 6th National Convention on Deaf Education and Awarding of the Most Outstanding Teachers of the Deaf at the Manila Pavilion Hotel, UN Avenue, Manila on October 24-26, 2005.
- 2. The theme for this year's Convention is <u>Building Literacy for the Deaf: Connecting Theory and Practice</u>. The Convention aims to provide the participants an opportunity to:
 - a. discuss current and innovative thrusts on the teaching of reading to the deaf;
 - b. adopt strategies in building literacy for the deaf;
 - c. raise the reading level of deaf pupils and youth; and
 - d. connect with other professionals, parents, and other stockholders in deaf education.
- 3. Special Education teachers and school administrators from public and private schools, education supervisors in SPED at the division and regional offices, chiefs/assistant chiefs of the Elementary and Secondary Education Divisions, Superintendents/Assistant Superintendents and parents of deaf and special needs children, representatives from the National Council for the Welfare of Disabled Persons, other GOs and NGOs working for children with special needs are expected to attend on official time.
- 4. A registration fee of Four Thousand Pesos (P4,000.00) shall be charged each participant to this <u>live-out</u> Convention. The fee includes three (3) lunches, six (6) snacks, study tours, conference kits, hand-outs, and certificates. Deaf teacher participants and parents of the deaf shall enjoy a fifty percent (50%) discount.
- 5. The program of activities, topics for presentation and resource speakers are found in Enclosure Nos, 1A and 1B while the pre-registration form is in Enclosure No. 2. Pre-registration is encouraged to facilitate the preparation of materials and should be sent to: **Ms. Mirla R. Olores**, Special Education Division, BEE, DepED, 2/F Bonifacio Bldg. Meralco Avenue, 1600 Pasig City.
- 6. Educators working for deaf children and youth are invited to present papers. The Presentor Information Form and Sample Abstract Form are found in Enclosure Nos. 3A and 3B.
- 7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
