

HAWAII CENTENNIAL COMMEMORATIVE STAMPS DESIGN COMPETITION

To: Bureau Directors

1. The Commission on Filipinos Overseas (CFO) as the lead agency for the commemoration of the Centennial of Filipino Migration to Hawaii, in partnership with the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) and the Philippine Postal Corporation (Philpost) will conduct a nationwide stamps design competition called "Hawaii Centennial Commemorative Stamps Design Competition".
2. The theme of the competition is "100 Years: The Filipino Legacy in Hawaii".
3. Elementary pupils, high school and college students in both public and private schools are encouraged to participate. The contest is also open to professionals such as Filipino artists, designers, illustrators and other interested parties.
4. Entries must be accompanied by an official entry form which may be obtained from the CFO, NCCA and local postmasters offices nationwide. Official entry forms may also be downloaded from www.cfo.gov.ph, www.ncca.gov.ph or www.philpost.gov.ph. A contestant needs to fill up only one official entry form despite multiple entries. Entries may only be submitted via domestic express mail service, international express mail service or registered mail at the following address:
