**IN-COUNTRY TRAINING PROGRAM ON STUDENT ASSESSMENT IN SECONDARY
VOCATIONAL TECHNICAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING (VTET)**

**To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Secondary Vocational Schools**

1. The SEAMEO-VOCTECH Regional Training Centre in Brunei, Darussalam, in cooperation with the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE), this Department, will conduct an In-Country Training Program on Student Assessment in VTET for school teachers and administrators. The training will be held at the Bayview Park Hotel, Roxas Boulevard, Manila on October 24-28, 2005.

2. The In-Country training program aims to:

- a. enhance the knowledge stock of teachers/head teachers and administrators on the principles and practices of student assessment in VTET; and
- b. upgrade their competencies in:
 - achievement based assessment;
 - performance based assessment;
 - alternative assessment;
 - constructing and writing test items, and
 - analyzing and interpreting assessment results.

3. A training specialist from the SEAMEO-VOCTECH Centre in Brunei, Darussalam will serve as the resource person in the training to be participated in by twelve (12) teachers/head teachers and/or administrators of tech-voc schools from each region. Grantees of the SEAMEO-VOCTECH scholarship program are likewise encouraged to attend the training.

4. A registration fee of Five Thousand Pesos (PhP5,000.00) shall be charged each participant to cover board and lodging, and training kit. The first meal will be the afternoon snack of October 24 and the last meal will be lunch of October 28. Travelling expenses and board and lodging of the training staff, supplies and materials and other incidental expenses relative to the training shall be charged against BSE funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
