

15TH ANNUAL NATIONAL CONVENTION OF THE PAMBANSANG SAMAHAN
PARA SA EDUKASYON SA PAGPAPAHALAGA (PSEP, INC.)

To: Bureau Directors

1. The *Pambansang Samahan para sa Edukasyon sa Pagpapahalaga* (PSEP), Inc. will hold its 15th Annual National Convention on November 23-25, 2005 at Brentwood Apartelle, Baguio City with the theme "*Pagpapatatag sa Pagkataong Pilipino: Mapanagutang Hamon sa mga Panlipunang Institusyon*".
2. The aims of the convention are to:
 - a. heighten awareness among participants as regards the vital role of social institutions in values transformation and national progress; and
 - b. strengthen the value concepts taught in the classrooms through the *Tagis Talino*, Poster Making, and *Sayawit sa Edukasyon sa Pagpapahalaga* Competitions.
3. The association will hold its 3rd *Tagis Talino* and *Sayawit sa Edukasyon sa Pagpapahalaga* Competitions and the 1st On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest during the convention.
4. The 2005-2006 Search for Outstanding School-Based Values Education (VE) Program, VE Supervisor, VE Educator, and Model K-PSEP will also be launched during the convention.
5. Participants to this convention are VE regional, division and district supervisors, PSEP officers and members, Values Education and *Makabayan* subject teachers both in the elementary and secondary, guidance counselors, K-PSEP officers and members, parents and other interested parties.
6. Arrangements for substitute teachers must be made to ensure that the classes of the participating teachers will not be disrupted.
7. A registration fee of Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP3,500.00) for the PSEP and Three Thousand Two Hundred Pesos (PhP3,200.00) for the K-PSEP will be charged each participant to cover board and lodging, food, convention materials, certificates, honoraria for speakers and other incidental expenses. A 5% discount will be given to participants who will register and pay two weeks before the convention (November 9, 2005). Payments for early registrants are accepted at the PSEP Secretariat, Rm. 304 B, Philippine Normal University (FNU) Graduate College, Manila from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

8. The first meal of the convention shall be dinner on November 22, 2005, 6:00-8:00 p.m. only. In view of this, participants are requested to register before the said time.
