The Department of Education Nurses Association (DENA) will hold its 5th Staff Development Seminar on December 6-8, 2005 at Manila Pavilion, United Nations Avenue, Ermita, Manila with the theme "Schools First Initiative: Bridging Quality Nursing Service and Academic Excellence for a Bright Child in a Healthy School Populace".
