POLICIES AND GUIDELINES FOR SPECIAL EDUCATION AT THE SECONDARY LEVEL

In line with the thrust on access to quality education, this Department through the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) shall institutionalize the Special Education Program at the Secondary level. Enclosed are the policies and guidelines of this Program.

Conformably, all divisions shall organize SPED programs in secondary schools where there are identified learners with special needs. Teachers and administrators who have completed training programs in SPED shall assist in the orientation or training of teachers to help these students.

Training programs for teachers of students with special needs at the regional, division and school level shall be initiated and conducted by the identified regional trainers in Special Education.

To sustain the continuing interest of supervisors, administrators and teachers in the implementation of the SPED program at the secondary level, DepEd shall plan and provide for incentives.

Immediate dissemination and compliance to this Order is desired.
