Background and Rationale of the Survey

The survey is a response to the need of the Department of Education (DepEd) to acquire a clear description of the conditions of over 261 Technical-Vocational Education (TVE) secondary schools in different regions in connection to the intention of DepEd Secretary Jesli A. Lapus to equip the high school students with technical-vocational (tech-voc) skills. The tech-voc education in the secondary education level is on top of the Secretary's initiatives in line with the poverty alleviation measures of the government.

SEAMEO INNOTECH is pleased to support DepEd's – TVE program by providing technical assistance in preparing profiles of the 261 TVE secondary schools in the target regions.
