ANNUAL DANCE MENTORS CONGRESS

The D' Professional Dance Council of the Philippines, Inc. will hold the Annual Dance Mentors Congress on May 13-15, 2010 at the Arellano University, Apolinario Mabini Campus, corner Menio and Donada Sts., Taft Avenue, Pasay City with the theme "Rhythms: Its Total Influence and Relevance in the Schools' Dance Curriculum", Season 2.

The activity aims to:

- a. discuss and understand the importance of rhythms in the school curriculum;
- b. learn to perform rhythms to further enrich the students school experiences;
- c. analyze the basic step patterns as well as the challenging and exciting variations of selected rhythms to ensure efficient teaching;
- d. introduce new strategies and techniques in teaching rhythms; and
- e. choreograph rhythms to showcase one's creativity.
