**CHANGE OF SCHEDULE OF THE REGIONAL FINALS OF THE 2011
METROBANK-MTAP-DEPED MATH CHALLENGE**

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 482, s. 2010 announcing the conduct of the **2011 Metrobank-MTAP-DepEd Math Challenge**, please be informed that the Regional Finals competition originally scheduled on **March 11, 2011 (Friday has been moved to March 12, 2011 (Saturday))**.

2. The change in schedule is due to the conflict of the original schedule with that of the National Achievement Test (NAT) for Secondary which is set on March 10, 2011. Since most of the MTAP officials who will facilitate the conduct of the Regional Finals are DepEd Supervisors in the National Capital Region (NCR), the earliest that they can leave and travel is March 11. The same is true to all fourth year high school Regional Finalists who need to travel to the regional venues outside their respective provinces. Thus, the Math Challenge Regional Finals is set on March 12, 2011.

3. In case there are still conflicts in schedule with other DepEd activities on March 12, the regional office/s concerned are advised to assign appropriate person to help administer the test on said date.
