**REGIONAL ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM IN SECONDARY
SPECIAL EDUCATION**

1. The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) and in cooperation with Link Center for the Deaf, will conduct the **Training on Enhancing Access to Secondary Education for Children with Hearing Impairment** by cluster on the following dates and venues:

2. The training aims to provide public high school teachers with specialized training in handling and communicating with deaf children that will eventually assist the schools in establishing new Special Education (SPED) programs and expanding the existing SPED programs for children with hearing impairment. Please see enclosure for the schedule of activities.

3. The participants to this training are public secondary SPED teachers and school heads (on the last day of the training) from eighteen (18) identified secondary schools offering SPED programs for the deaf in the region. Teachers from secondary schools offering SPED Programs for the Deaf not listed in DepEd Order No. 50, s. 2009 may also qualify as teacher-participants.

4. The Link Center for the Deaf shall cover the cost of participants' training fee, materials (seminar kits and sign language manuals), and meals, while their lodging, travel as well as other related expenses during the conduct of the training shall be borne by the participants chargeable to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
