URGENT PRAYERS FOR FILIPINOS IN LIBYA

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools
All Others Concerned

1. In light of the continuing crisis in Libya affecting thousands of Filipino overseas workers, the Department of Education (DepEd) is calling on all schools to offer prayers to put an end to the bloodshed in the North African country in the form of **a minute of fervent silent prayer**, a **candle-lighting activity**, and a **special prayer or ecumenical service**.
2. All school heads are encouraged to include in their daily activities an appropriate gesture of solidarity and support for all affected Filipinos, and pray for their immediate repatriation and safety for those who decide to stay in the violence-stricken land.
3. This shall be observed immediately upon the receipt of this Memorandum and until all of them will be able to escape the turmoil of the gripping Libya.
4. Wide and immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
