RESULTS OF THE 2010 NATIONAL QUALIFYING EXAMINATION FOR PRINCIPALS

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) through the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) announces the **Results of the 2010 National Qualifying Examination for Principals (NQEP)**. The 2010 NQEP was simultaneously administered nationwide on January 23, 2011.
2. The cut-off score of the 2010 NQEP is placed at ninety (90) percentile based on the total standard scores obtained by the examinees in all performance areas covered by the examination with an equivalent raw score of 101.
3. The 2010 NQEP consisted of 170 test items. These were equitably spread across the nine (9) performance areas or leadership experience dimensions of school heads, to include:
 - a. School Leadership;
 - b. Instructional Leadership;
 - c. Creating a Student-Centered Learning Climate;
 - d. Professional Human Resource Development;
 - e. Parent Involvement and Building Community;
 - f. School Management and Daily Operations;
 - g. Personal Integrity and Interpersonal Sensitivity;
 - h. English Language Proficiency; and
 - i. Reading Comprehension.
4. Given the cut-off score of 90 percentile, a total of 924 test takers or examinees hurdled in the said examination, representing approximately 9.5% of the total aspirants of 9,778. Enclosed is the Official Result of the 2010 NQEP.
5. The detailed information contained in the results published in the website are as follows:
 - a. Complete name and region of the examinee;
 - b. Percentile rank of the examinee;
 - c. Raw score and standard score of the examinee per performance area; and
 - d. Total raw scores, total standard scores and percentile equivalent.
