COMPUTATION OF PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS' PROPORTIONAL VACATION PAY (PVP) FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2010-2011

To: Regional Directors

Schools Division/City Superintendents

Heads, Public Elementary and Secondary Schools

- 1. This is to provide the field offices with a uniform basis on the computation of the Proportional Vacation Pay (PVP) entitled to each of the public elementary and secondary school teachers under the teachers leave basis.
- 2. Teachers who have continuous services for the School Year 2010-2011, from *June 15, 2010* to *April 8, 2011*, shall be entitled to **74 days total PVP** earned from summer and Christmas vacation days, computed as follows:

Total no. of days served	= 298 days
from June 15, 2010 to April 8, 2011 Less: No. of Christmas vacation days earned from December 18, 2010 to January 2, 2011	= <u>-16 days</u>
Actual days served	= 282 days
Multiply factor	х <u>0.262</u>
Total PVP earned from the no. of summer	= 74 days
and Christmas vacation days	
Less: No. of Christmas vacation days	<u>= -16 days</u>
No. of the summer vacation days earned	= 58 days
from April 9 to June 5, 2011	·

3. Factor **0.262** shall be used for the computation of absences and PVP this school year. Below is the **derivation of factor 0.262**.

No. of summer vacation days	= 58 days
Add: No. of Christmas vacation days	= + <u>16 days</u>
Total PVP	= 74 days
(Summer and Christmas vacation days)	
Divided by actual days served	= 282 days
