**NATIONAL LEADERSHIP TRAINING FOR STUDENT
 GOVERNMENT OFFICERS (NLTSGO)**

To: Regional Directors
 Schools Division/City Superintendents
 Heads, Public and Private Secondary Schools

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) through the Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (DepEd-CSCA), in partnership with The Master's Lighthouse Foundation (TMLF), Ateneo Consultants for Organizational Development and Empowerment (CODE) [former Ateneo Student Trainers (STRAINS)] and Baguio City National High School, will conduct the **National Leadership Training for Student Government Officers (NLTSGO)** with the theme "*Pinoy Makes It Happen*", on October 26-31, 2011 at the Baguio Teachers Camp (BTC) and Baguio City National High School (BCNHS).

2. The training serves, in general, to develop and/or enhance the management and leadership knowledge, skills and attitudes of elected Supreme Student Government (SSG) officers through dynamic plenary sessions, interactive break-out sessions and enriched discussions, and to provide a venue for sharing best practices in the Student Government Program (SGP). In particular, the training commits to align the programs, projects and activities (PPAs) of the SSGs nationwide to the thrusts of His Excellency President Benigno S. Aquino III and the DepEd and to engage SSG officers to implement the PPAs in their schools and communities.

3. The leadership training aims to:

- a. expose student-leaders to various leadership concepts and models, and to different leaders and personalities in politics, business and the academe to give them a broader outlook and example in their leadership role;
- b. harness the potential of the SSG to encourage a vibrant and participative studentry for school and community development and as an effective partner of DepEd in achieving quality education and academic excellence;
- c. help student-leaders understand the intricacies of leading and managing the school SSGs and adopt relevant courses of action in response to its evolving and emerging roles and functions;
- d. highlight best practices in running the SSGs;
- e. formulate a dynamic, feasible, doable and concrete action plan for implementation in the schools based on the mandated PPAs of the SSG pursuant to DepEd Order No. 49, s. 2011 and assist SSG officers in its implementation;
- f. organize the National Federation of Supreme Student Governments (NFSSG) for School Year 2011-2012; and,



- g. conduct the National SSG Awards to recognize outstanding SSG implementers of *Brigada Eskwela*, The Kindergarten Project Donation and Advocacy, and Teachers' Month Campaign and World Teachers' Day.
4. The participants to this training are the duly-elected officers of the SSG for SY 2011-2012, including their Teacher-Advisers, and Division and Regional Education Supervisors of *Araling Panlipunan* or Student Government Program (SGP) Coordinators.
5. The travel of the participants shall be **on official business**. The registration fee for each participant is Five Thousand Pesos (PhP5,000.00) chargeable to school, division, and regional funds, MOOE, Local School Board Funds, Supreme Student Government (SSG) Developmental Fee pursuant to DepEd Order No. 49, s. 2011, PTA Funds or funds sourced from private organizations, subject to its availability and the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The registration fees collected shall be used to directly pay expenses for accommodation and meals from dinner of Day 0 to breakfast of Day 5, use of venue, light and sound services, honoraria, certificates, medals, trophies, prizes, t-shirts, bags, souvenir programs, tokens, communications, entertainment services, events and consultancy services, purchase of equipment, supplies and materials and other related, necessary and incidental expenses of the program. The participants from the private schools shall make arrangements with their respective schools in connection with their attendance.
6. All regional directors (RDs), schools division/city superintendents, (SDSs) and School Principals/Heads (SPs/SHs) are encouraged to send participants to the NLTSGO. Allocation for each region is at one hundred sixty (160) participants who are required to pre-register on or before **September 30, 2011**. The regional and division education supervisors/coordinators of *Araling Panlipunan* or Student Government Program Coordinators are encouraged to attend the NLTSGO, and to coordinate, form and assist in the requirements of their respective delegation.
7. The members of the National Organizing Committee (NOC) and Secretariat are authorized to travel three (3) days before and two (2) days after the NLTSGO. Enclosed are the following documents:
- Enclosure No. 1 - Pre-Registration Form (PRF)
 - Enclosure No. 2 - Tentative Schedule of Activities
 - Enclosure No. 3 - Guidelines for the Training
 - Enclosure No. 4 - List of the National Organizing Committee and Secretariat which serves as their Authority to Travel
8. The DepEd-CSCA, through its Head, is authorized to exercise necessary management actions and decisions in the implementation of the NLTSGO.

PRE-TRAINING PREPARATION

Pre-Registration Requirement

To ensure your participation, please send and/or fax in your Pre-Registration Form (PRF) to the Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (CSCA) at (02) 631-8495 or (02) 636-3603 or thru email cscaportal@gmail.com on or before September 30, 2011.

To facilitate registration, participants should download the Registration Form from www.facebook.com/csca.deped and accomplish the same in five copies before proceeding to Baguio City.

TRAINING PROPER

Arrival of Participants/Registration

Participants are expected to arrive on October 26, 2011. Upon arrival, please proceed to the Quezon Hall of the Teachers Camp for verification, payment, billeting assignments and distribution of kits. **Advance registration starts on October 24, 2011 starting at 10:00 AM.**

Pre-registered participants shall be given priority in the distribution of bags, shirts and other event collaterals.

Payment

Payment of the registration fee must be in cash. Check payment may be accepted in exceptional cases provided checks are named for the account of the Department of Education-Baguio City National High School and provided further that prior coordination has been made with the CSCA. No personal checks shall be accepted.

Billeting and Accommodation

Accommodation shall start in the morning of October 26, 2011 and end in the morning of October 31, 2011. **Charges for advance and extended accommodation shall be for the account of the participants.**

Meals

Meals shall start dinner of October 26, 2011 and end breakfast of October 31, 2011. **Lost meal tickets will not be replaced.**

Attire

All participants are required to bring a set of business attire and a formal wear.

Wearing of ID

IDs must be worn at all times for your security. No participant shall be allowed entry in the plenary, mess and other session halls without the ID.

Medical Needs

All participants are presumed in good health. The Medical Clinic is available 24 hours a day. Expenses in regard to hospitalization shall be charged against personal funds.
