**SCHOLARSHIP GRANTS FOR SPECIAL EDUCATION (SPED) TEACHERS,
ADMINISTRATORS AND SUPERVISORS UNDER THE HUMAN
RESOURCE TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT (HRTD) FUND**

Schools Division/City Superintendents

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) through the Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE), Special Education (SPED) Division, will conduct the **Scholarship Grants for SPED Teachers, Administrators and Supervisors under the Human Resource Training and Development (HRTD) Fund**. This is in support to the Department's thrust on improving the quality of education for children with special needs.

2. The scholarship program aims to provide the SPED teachers, administrators and supervisors' knowledge and skills on various educational programs and interventions appropriate for children with special needs. This Program will be conducted in the following selected Centers of Excellence (CEOs) beginning April 10, 2012:

<i>Visayas Area</i> Venue Participants	Cebu Normal University (CNU), Cebu City Regions VI, VII and VIII
<i>Mindanao Area</i> Venue Participants	University of Southeastern Philippines, Davao City Regions IX, X, XI, XII, Caraga and ARMM

3. Priority nominees for new teacher-scholars who were already identified based on the monitoring results are listed in Enclosure No. 1, while the regions/divisions which do not have nominees shall be screened by the existing Regional Integrated Scholarship Committee (RISC) based on the criteria set in Enclosure No. 2. The deadline for the submission of nominees to the SPED Division, BEE is on **March 26, 2012**. The list of the returning teacher-scholars together with the documents and the Memorandum of Agreement or Training Contact duly signed by the proper authorities concerned (see Enclosure No. 3) shall be forwarded to the SPED-BEE, DepEd Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City on or before **March 30, 2012**.

4. The scholars are entitled to their salaries, course tuition fees and stipend. Travel expenses at the most economical mode of transportation shall also be provided including per diem for two (2) days (1 day before and 1 day after) in going to and from the venue which will be paid on the last week of the course.



Guidelines for the Selection of New SPED Scholars

1. The **Regional Integrated Scholarship Committee (RISC)** shall screen and identify the new teacher-grantees to be considered in the program following a set of criteria.
2. The **RISC** shall submit the list of scholars to the Special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education on or before **March 26, 2012**. The names indicated in the list shall be **final**.
3. The following are the criteria for the selection of nominees for the training courses:
 - A bachelor's degree holder related to the area of scholarship with a grade point average of not lower than **2/ B / 85**
 - Has been a teacher for at least three years under permanent status with a performance rating of at least **Very Satisfactory (VS)**
 - Not more than 45 years old
 - Has no pending administrative case and/or criminal record
 - Has been certified by a government physician to be physically and mentally fit and not pregnant during the scholarship period
 - Has not availed of any scholarship/training program for at least two (2) years
 - Possesses leadership potential, facilitation skills, positive attitude to mentor or coach other teachers in his/her school / division as necessary
 - Can communicate effectively in English
 - Can develop and implement relevant re-entry plan
 - Must have a list of prospective clientele for the organization of a class right after the training.
4. The documents / pertinent papers to be submitted by the nominees to their Regional Integrated Scholarship Committees are as follows:
 - CSC Form 212 (Personal Data Sheet) with a 2"x2" recent photo duly certified by the administrative officer
 - Certified photocopy of the **transcript of records**
 - Form 86 (health certificate) from an accredited government hospital
 - Service Record
 - Endorsement from the superintendent
 - Duly accomplished scholarship contract between the scholar and the Schools Division Superintendent to guarantee the implementation of re-entry plan.
 - List of prospective clientele must be submitted with the other documents
5. Selected scholars will be informed through the regional offices.

4. Submit to the Bureau of Elementary Education, at the end of the training, a copy of his/her action plan. It is also expected that scholars for the visual impairment should furnish copies of his/her action plan to the Resources of the Blind;
5. Immediately report to his/her station and assume his/her function upon the completion or termination of the training;
6. Organize SPED programs or classes in the area where he/she was trained;
7. Shall serve his/her school/agency for at least **(2)** years after the training;
8. Shall refund in full to DepED all expenses incurred on tuition fees, stipend, salaries and other benefits for failure to comply with any of the foregoing conditions, through willful neglect, resignation from service, transfer to other government agencies, voluntary retirement or other causes within his/her control. Likewise, scholars for visual impairment shall refund in full expenses incurred on transportation and stipend for reason beyond the scholar's control, the conditions do not apply, provided all documentary requirements including the doctor's certification are submitted and are acceptable to DepED and Resources for the Blind.
9. Shall live up to the terms and conditions of the scholarship.
