14TH NATIONAL EDUCATORS' COOPERATIVE SUMMIT AND ANNUAL GENERAL ASSEMBLY (AGA), AND CONSULTATION AND MEMBERSHIP FORUM OF TEACHERS' COOPERATIVES OF THE PHILIPPINE FEDERATION OF TEACHERS AND EMPLOYEES COOPERATIVES (PFTEC)

1. The Philippine Federation of Teachers and Employees Cooperatives (PFTEC) will conduct its **14th National Educators' Cooperative Summit (NECS) and Annual General Assembly (AGA)** with the theme "*Cooperative Enterprises Build a Better World,*" and the sub-theme is "*Transformative Cooperatives, People, Planet, Prosperity and Peace*" at the 22nd Floor, Makati City Session Hall, Makati City on April 12-14, 2012 and the conduct of the **Consultation and Membership Forum of Teachers' Cooperatives** on March 29-30; March 30-31; and April 2-3, 2012.
2. The Summit and General Assembly aims to:
 - a. explain the overall direction, the three (3)-point agenda of the Cooperative Development Authority (CDA), the direction of PFTEC and DepEd, thus, increase at least 50% membership in the teachers' cooperative sector;
 - b. enable the DepEd Coop members, credit cooperatives and their member-owners to share ideas on how to raise awareness about financial cooperatives locally, regionally and globally; and transformative cooperatives for people, planet, prosperity and peace for International Year of Cooperatives (IYC) 2012;
 - c. contribute ideas to foster cooperation among the cooperatives and add to the success of the membership campaign through the United Federation of Cooperatives (UFC); and
 - d. educate the teachers, the DepEd coordinators on cooperative and to comply with the required training on "Basic Cooperative Course" under Republic Act (RA) No. 9520.
3. The target participants are two (2) cooperative officers, designated DepEd Coop coordinators, regional directors (RDs), principal, directors of services, schools division/city superintendents (SDSs). The DepEd officials joining as participants and the Cooperative officers shall attend on **official time only** and their registration fee and transportation shall be charged to their cooperative fund.

5. The confirmed participants will be given priority on training kit, materials, meals and hostel reservation upon on-line deposit of registration fee to PFTEC through Banco de Oro (BDO) Account No.: 1530079940.
