**IDENTIFYING THE CENTERS OF EXCELLENCE (COEs) FOR TEACHER EDUCATION
AS TRAINING PROVIDERS FOR GRADE 7 TEACHER TRAINING
IN THE K TO 12 BASIC EDUCATION CURRICULUM**

Heads, Public Secondary Schools

1. Cognizant of the significant role of the Teacher Education Council (TEC) accredited Teacher Education Institutes (TEIs) as Centers of Excellence (COEs) in providing quality teacher program and training, and of the long-time partnership the Department of Education (DepEd) has had with them in various teacher trainings, the DepEd is engaging their services in the Training of Trainers (TOT) and Grade 7 teachers in all subject areas on the Grade 7 Curriculum of the K to 12 Basic Education Program.
2. These TEIs have satisfactorily delivered many cost-effective teacher training packages for the Department such as Teacher Induction Program (TIP), Certificate Programs for Secondary Science and Mathematics teachers who are non-majors and other related training programs.
3. The training of Grade 7 teachers in all subject areas will be conducted by the accredited TEIs in each region. The list of TEIs providers is enclosed.
4. The conduct of training shall be covered by a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the TEIs and the DepEd.
5. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
