## COMPUTATION OF PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS' PROPORTIONAL VACATION PAY (PVP) FOR SCHOOL YEAR (SY) 2011-2012

To: Regional Directors

Schools Division/City Superintendents

Heads, Public Elementary and Secondary Schools

- 1. This is to provide the field offices with a uniform basis for the computation of the Proportional Vacation Pay (PVP) entitled to all public elementary and secondary school teachers under the teacher's leave basis.
- 2. For School Year (SY) 2011-2012, teachers who have continuous services from June 6, 2011 to March 30, 2012 shall be entitled to **seventy-eight (78) days total of PVP** from Summer and Christmas vacation days, which is computed as follows:

Total Number of days served	=	299 days
from June 6, 2011 to March 30, 2012		·
Less: Number of Christmas vacation days earned	=	-13 days
from December 21, 2011 to January 2, 2012		
Actual days served	=	286 days
Multiply factor		x <b>0.273</b>
Total PVP earned from the number of Summer	=	78 days
and Christmas vacation days		
Less: Number of Christmas vacation days	=	<u>-13 days</u>
Number of Summer vacation days earned	=	65 days
from March 31 to June 03, 2012		

3. Factor **0.273** shall be used for the computation of absences and PVP for SY 2011-2012. Below is the **derivation of factor 0.273**.

Number of Summer vacation days=65 daysAdd: Number of Christmas vacation days=+13 daysTotal PVP=78 days

(Summer and Christmas vacation days)

Divided by actual days served = 286 days

Multiply factor = **0.273**
