**YOUTH FOR ENVIRONMENT IN SCHOOLS (YES) PROGRAM
REVIEW, EVALUATION AND PLANNING CONFERENCE**

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public Elementary and Secondary Schools

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 52, s. 2011 (Strengthening Environmental Education in Public and Private Schools) and DepEd Order No. 93, s. 2011 (Mandated Programs, Projects and Activities, Various Forms, and Targets Pertinent to the Youth for Environment in Schools Program), the Department of Education (DepEd), through the Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (CSCA), will conduct the **Youth for Environment in Schools (YES) Program Review, Evaluation and Planning Conference** on September 17-21, 2012 at the Gardens of Malasag, Eco-Tourism Village, Cugman, Cagayan de Oro City.

2. The Review, Evaluation and Planning Conference aims to:

- a. identify, discuss and resolve gaps, concerns and issues in the implementation of the YES Program pertinent to DepEd Order Nos. 52 and 93, s. 2011;
- b. set mechanisms to standardize/synchronize the implementation of programs, projects and activities (PPAs) and the reporting of accomplishments of schools, districts, divisions and regions relative to the YES Program;
- c. design strategies to increase pupils and students' membership to the YES-O and sustain their active interest and participation in its programs, projects and activities in the school, district, division, regional and national levels;
- d. discuss, suggest and design strategies to strengthen the YES-O and consolidate grassroots environmental learning and action; and
- e. review and evaluate the implementation of the monitoring tools and program targets pursuant to DepEd Order Nos. 52 and 93, s. 2011.

3. The participants to this conference are Regional Elementary and Secondary Education Program Supervisors in Science or the Regional YES Program Coordinators, Presidents of the Regional Federation of Supreme Student Governments (RFSSG), selected Schools Heads (SHs) and Teachers implementing the YES-O (to be identified by the DepEd-CSCA), representatives from the Office of the Undersecretary for Legal and Legislative Affairs and DepEd-CSCA personnel including resource speakers and facilitators. The List of Participants which serves as Travel Authority is enclosed.

4. The participants are expected to be at the venue in time for lunch on September 17, 2012 until breakfast of September 21, 2012. The members of the DepEd-CSCA staff are authorized to travel one (1) day before and one (1) day after the conference.

5. All Regional Elementary and Secondary Education Program Supervisors in Science or the Regional YES Program Coordinators are required to submit on or before September 17, 2012, the following:

- a. Name, Contact Number and E-mail Address of the Division YES Program Coordinators; and
- b. A Certification signed by each Schools Division/City Superintendent (SDS) to the effect that all public elementary and secondary schools within the Division have organized their respective YES-Os pursuant to DepEd Order No. 52, s. 2011 and DepEd Order No. 93, s. 2011; or in case of failure to organize the YES-O and/or comply with said issuances, a duly certified consolidated list of schools without YES-O and the reason/s of each school for its failure to organize the YES-O and/or comply with pertinent DepEd issuances, including the significant actions undertaken by the SH and the SDS to organize the YES-O and/or comply with all YES-related DepEd issuances.

6. Transportation and other incidental expenses of Regional Elementary and Secondary Education Program Supervisors in Science or the Regional YES Program Coordinators and the selected School Heads and Teachers shall be charged to local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations, while similar expenses of Presidents of the Regional Federation of Supreme Student Governments (RFSSG) shall be charged to the Division Funds. Expenses for board and lodging of all participants, supplies and materials, honorarium, including transportation and other incidental expenses of the representatives of the Office of the Undersecretary for Legal and Legislative Affairs, DepEd-CSCA personnel, resource persons and facilitators shall be charged to DepEd-OSEC Funds.
