SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR SPECIAL EDUCATION (SPED) TEACHERS, ADMINISTRATORS AND SUPERVISORS

- In support of the thrust on improving quality of education for children with special needs, the Department of Education (DepEd) through the Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE)-Special Education (SPED) Division announces the conduct of the Scholarship Program for Special Education (SPED) Teachers, Administrators and Supervisors under the capability building program of the Human Resource Training and Development (HRTD) Funds.
- 2. This scholarship designed as a customized training, aims to provide the SPED teachers, administrators and supervisors with the knowledge and skills on various educational programs and interventions appropriate for children with special needs. The programs for teachers will have two batches; namely:
 - a. Batch of the Returning Scholars who will complete the 18 units on Gifted and Talented, Learning Disability, and Visual Impairment; and
 - b. New Batch of Scholars who will take up Hearing Impairment, Intellectual Disability, Visual Impairment, and Multiple Disability with Visual Impairment.
- The two-term scholarship program (first term-summer; second term-from August to December) for administrators and supervisors on the Organization and Supervision of SPED Program shall also be conducted.
- 4. The program will be conducted in the following selected Centers of Excellence (COEs) beginning April 10, 2013:

- 5. Priority nominees for new teachers/administrators/supervisor-scholars who were already identified based on the monitoring results are listed in Enclosure No. 1, while the regions/divisions which do not have nominees shall be screened by the existing Regional Integrated Scholarship Committee (RISC) based on the criteria set in Enclosure Nos. 2a and 2b. The deadline for the submission of names of nominees to the SPED Division, BEE is on **March 18, 2013**.
- 6. The returning teacher-scholars listed in Enclosure No. 3 should bring with them the documents and the notarized Memorandum of Agreement (Training Contract) duly signed by the proper authorities concerned (Enclosure No. 4) to the university they will enroll.
- 7. The scholars are entitled to receive their salaries. Course tuition fees and stipend and travel expenses using the most economical mode of transportation shall also be provided including per diem for two days (one day before and one day after) in going to and from the training venue which shall be charged to HRTD Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

A. Guidelines for the Selection of New SPED Scholars

- 1. The Regional Integrated Scholarship Committee (RISC) shall screen and identify the new teacher-grantees to be considered in the program following a set of criteria.
- 2. The RISC shall submit the list of scholars to the Special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education on or before February 28, 2013. The names indicated in the list shall be final.
- 3. The following are the criteria for the selection of nominees for the training courses:
 - A bachelor's degree holder related to the area of scholarship with a grade point average of not lower than 2/ B / 85
 - Has been a teacher for at least three years under permanent status with a performance rating of at least **Very Satisfactory** (VS)
 - Not more than 45 years old
 - Has no pending administrative case and/or criminal record
 - Has been certified by a government physician to be physically and mentally fit and not pregnant during the scholarship period
 - Has not availed of any scholarship/training program for at least two (2) years
 - Possesses leadership potential, facilitation skills, positive attitude to mentor or coach other teachers in his/her school / division as necessary
 - Can communicate effectively in English
 - Can develop and implement relevant re-entry plan
 - Must have a list of prospective clientele for the organization of a class right after the training.
- 4. The documents / pertinent papers to be submitted by the nominees to their Regional Integrated Scholarship Committees are as follows:
 - CSC Form 212 (Personal Data Sheet) with a 2"x2" recent photo duly certified by the administrative officer
 - Certified photocopy of the transcript of records
 - Form 86 (health certificate) from an accredited government hospital
 - Service Record
 - Endorsement from the superintendent
 - Duly accomplished scholarship contract between the scholar and the Schools Division Superintendent to guarantee the implementation of re-entry plan.
 - List of prospective clientele must be submitted with the other documents
- 5. Selected scholars will be informed through the regional offices.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION OF NOMINEES FOR THE OAS-SPED TRAINING (REVISED)

- 1. Is a Bachelor's degree holder with a grade point average of not lower than 2, B or 85;
- 2. Holds a permanent status for the last three (3) years with Very Satisfactory (VS) Performance
- 3. Is actually administering or supervising SPED Programs;
- 4. Is not more than 55 years of age;
- 5. Is not pregnant at the time of nomination;
- 6. Has no administrative and/or criminal record;
- 7. Has been certified by government physician to be medically fit;
- 8. Has not availed of ant scholarship for the last two (2) years; and
- 9. Has high sense of commitment to implement the program.

- Form 212 (Personal Data Sheet) duly certified by the Administrative Officer

- 4. Service Record
- Certification from the District/Division/Supervisor/Superintendent on nominee's performance rating relevant to actual administration/supervision of SPED and recommending him/her for the training
- 6. Endorsement from the Regional Director
- 7. Duly accomplished Training Contract (Memorandum of Agreement)
- 8. Authority to Travel

- 3. Conduct himself / herself in such a manner as not to bring disgrace or dishonor for himself/herself, his/her school/agency/ and the Department;
- 4. Submit to the Bureau of Elementary Education, Special Education Division at the end of the training, a copy of his/her action plan. It is also expected that scholars for the visual impairment should furnish copies of his/her action plan to the Resources for the Blind.
- Immediately report to his/her station and assume his/her function upon the completion or termination of the training;
- 6. Organize SPED programs or classes in the area where he/she was trained;
- 7. Shall serve his/her school/agency for at least (2) years after the training;
- Shall refund in full to DepED all expenses incurred on tuition fees, stipend, salaries and other benefits for failure to comply with any of the foregoing conditions, through willful >
 - neglect, resignation from service, transfer to other government agencies, voluntary retirement or other causes within his/her control. Likewise, scholars for visual impairment shall refund in full to the Resources for the Blind all expenses incurred on transportation and stipend for reasons beyond the scholar's control, the conditions do not apply, provided all documentary requirements including the doctor's certification are submitted and are acceptable to DepED.
