

- Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012 entitled DepEd Child Protection Policy which stipulates the Policy and Guidelines on Protecting Children in School from Abuse, Violence, Exploitation, Discrimination, Bullying and Other Forms of Abuse, all public and private elementary and secondary schools shall build the capacities of school personnel, pupils, students, and parents to understand and deal with child abuse, exploitation, violence and discrimination cases, bullying and peer violence.
- In this connection, the Office of the Undersecretary for Legal and Legislative Affairs will conduct the National Training of Trainors on Child Protection by batch/region on the following dates:

- 7. The selection of the participants is based following criteria:
 - a. He/She must be well-versed on child development;
 - b. He/She must be familiar with child's rights;
 - c. He/She must be aware of Child Protection Policies; and
 - d. He/She must be trained on facilitation skills.
- 8. The Training Teams shall be composed of the regional and division participants when the same training package shall be rolled-out in the division, district or school level. Morever, the division offices shall conduct the information dissemination activities on protecting school children, youth and adult learners from abuse, violence, exploitation, discrimination, bullying or peer abuse and other related cases.
- 9. All participants are expected to be at the venue on Day 0, Monday. The first meal to be served is lunch. Check-out time will be after breakfast on Friday, Day 4. Enclosed is the Training Matrix.
- 10. Expenses which will be incurred during the roll-out of this training may be charged to division/local, INSET, and GAD Funds, subject to the usual accounting rules and regulations
- 11. Travel expenses of regional and division participants shall be charged to local funds/Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) while food and accommodation of all participants and travel expenses of CO Training Team and staff and other incidental expenses shall be charged to OSEC Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
