#### 2017 NATIONAL LITERACY CONFERENCE

To: Undersecretaries **Assistant Secretaries** Bureau and Service Directors Schools Division Superintendents

All Others Concerned

- In celebration of the annual Literacy Week as stipulated in Presidential Proclamation No. 239 entitled Declaring the Period from September 2 to 8 of Every Year as Literacy Week, the Department of Education (DepEd), through the Literacy Coordinating Council (LCC), in cooperation and coordination with other government organizations (GOs), local government units (LGUs), private organizations (POs) and nongovernment organizations (NGOs), will hold the 2017 National Literacy Conference with the theme Lifelong Learning in a Digital World from September 27 to 29, 2017 in Cagayan de Oro City (excluding travel time).
- 2. The Conference aims to:
  - a. explore the current local and international trends and innovations in digital literacy;
  - b. exchange experiences in utilizing digital interventions in literacy programs for lifelong learning; and
  - c. promote the wide use of ICT in implementing literacy programs and practices.
- One of the highlights of the Conference is the presentation of the National Literacy Hall of Fame Award to Balanga City, and Municipality of Cuyo, Palawan for being three-time first place winners in the Outstanding Local Government Unit (City Level and Municipal Level Class B) category in the National Literacy Awards.

Participants from this Department shall attend on official business. Transportation and other incidental expenses shall be charged to local funds of their respective offices, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations, while registration fees may be charged to local funds or the Special Education Fund (SEF). a. There shall be a maximum of 54 participants from the local government units (3 LGUs per region), and 36 participants from the Barangay preferably the Chairperson (2 per region) involved in the universalization of literacy.
Other Government and Nongovernment Organizations (NGOs)	<ul> <li>a. There shall be a maximum of 36 participants from the NGOs and civil service organizations (2 per region) involved in universalizing literacy in every region.</li> <li>b. There shall be a maximum of 36 participants (2 per region) from academic institutions particularly those in charge of the National Service Training Program-Literacy Training Service (NSTP-LTS).</li> </ul>

Each participant shall be charged a registration fee of Six Thousand Pesos (P6,000.00) to cover expenses for board and lodging, handouts, kits, and other supplies and materials. Participants are encouraged to register early. Payments may be deposited on or before **September 15, 2017** to:
