**3<sup>rd</sup> PHILIPPINE INTERNATIONAL FLORA AND FAUNA  
GREEN LIVING EXPO (PIFGEX 3)**

The RPN Flora and Fauna Inc. will hold the 3<sup>rd</sup> Philippine International Flora and Fauna Green Living Expo (PIFGEX 3) on July 22-25, 2010 at the World Trade Center, Pasay City with the theme "Gifts of Nature".

As part of this endeavor, exhibits, free daily lectures and seminars, flower and photography competitions, conference on flora and fauna, demos, workshops and product launches will be held within the activity areas.

Schools/Universities may participate in some of the competitions (song and dance interpretation, poster-making and essay writing) and learn from the exhibits and special seminars that will be part of the four-day event.

The song and dance interpretation and poster-making contests are open to all elementary and high school students. Top three from each category will be awarded first, second and third place winners. All the finalists will receive certificates, trophies and cash prizes. For the song and dance interpretation contest, a minimum of seven (7) minutes and a maximum of nine (9) minutes will be allotted for each presentation. Deadline of registration is March 19, 2010. For the poster-making contest, all artworks must be placed on a 24 x 30 inch master board and any medium can be used. The deadline of submission is June 15, 2010.

The essay-writing and Young Generations Invention (YGI) contests are open to high school students only. The essay should be composed of 900-1,200 words. All inventions in the YGI contest will be judged according to creativity, originality, practicality and relevance to the theme. Deadline of submission for both contests is April 20, 2010.

The nature lovers, advocates of plant and animal conservation, flower clubs/stylists, garden enthusiasts, animal raisers and hobbyists, students, teachers, local and foreign visitors, industry practitioners, suppliers, traders, organizations, and the general public are invited to attend this activity.
