**2010 NATIONAL YOUTH SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY AND ENVIRONMENT
SUMMER CAMP (NYSTESC)**

The Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs, Inc. (PSYSC) will conduct the 2010 National Youth Science, Technology and Environment Summer Camp ((NYSTESC) on April 7-10, 2010 at Royale Tagaytay Country Club, E. Aguinaldo Highway, Buck Estate, Alfonso, Cavite with the theme "Alert Level 10: The RESCUE (Resilient and Empowered Science Clubbers even Under Emergency)."

This year's camp will tackle the topics on Disaster Management in the Philippine context. It will feature a series of lectures and workshops (for students and teachers), exposure trips, and other educational and fun-filled activities.

Each science club may send high school students accompanied by their teacher-adviser.

The registration fee for the first 750 reserved participants is Five Thousand Pesos (PhP5,000.00) for PSYSC affiliated schools and Eight Thousand Pesos (PhP8,000.00) for non-affiliated schools. For the succeeding reservations, the registration fee is Six Thousand One Hundred Twenty Pesos (PhP6,120.00) for affiliated schools and Nine Thousand One Hundred Twenty Pesos (PhP9,120.00) for non affiliated schools inclusive of kits, insurance, board and lodging from dinner of April 7 to lunch of April 10, 2010.
