**8TH NATIONAL BAKAS SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON HISTORIOGRAPHY
AND THE SOCIAL SCIENCES**

The Bagong Kasaysayan-Bahay Saliksikan sa Kasaysayan (BAKAS) together with the National Historical Institute and Catholic Schools and Colleges will hold the 8th National BAKAS Seminar-Workshop on Historiography and the Social Sciences with the theme “Kasarian: Mga Pagpapakahulugan sa Daloy ng Kasaysayan” on May 5-7, 2010 at the Little Theater, CAS Building, University of the Philippines (UP), Manila.

The seminar-workshop aims to:

- a. appraise the teachers of recent developments in the Philippine social sciences, particularly on issues concerning Philippine history, society and culture;
- b. provide the teachers with a holistic understanding of the social sciences – i.e., an understanding crucial to a meaningful approach to the integration of the social sciences in the various subject areas and vice versa; and
- c. inform and help the teachers appreciate recent curricular developments, as well as techniques and methods of teaching and research, including the use of modern information technology/multi-media in the classroom.

The participants to this activity are school teachers, professors and educators from both public and private elementary, secondary and tertiary levels nationwide.

A registration fee of Two Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (PhP2,800.00) will be charged for non-BAKAS members and Two Thousand Five Hundred (PhP2,500.00) for BAKAS members inclusive of the seminar kit (containing paper abstracts, selected papers, an electronic compilation of speakers’ presentations), a.m. and p.m. snacks and lunch for three (3) days, and certificate of attendance/participation. Participants will also get a chance to take home free publications, maps, instructional materials, school supplies, and the like.
