NATIONAL SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON MORAL AND VALUES EDUCATION

The University of the Philippines (UP), College of Education History and Philosophy of Education Program will hold the **National Seminar-Workshop on Moral and Values Education** with the theme, "*Critical Thinking and Reasoning in Values Education: Goals, Content, and Pedagogy*" on September 4, 2010, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., at the UP College of Education, Diliman, Quezon City.

The objectives of this activity are to:

- a. state clearly the place of values education and moral reasoning in the context of formal education;
- b. formulate and justify some possible goals of Values and Moral Education;
- c. identify the relevant skills for effective moral reasoning and problem solving;
- d. determine appropriate teaching techniques and styles for teaching moral reasoning and problem solving;
- e. develop appropriate exercises for the advancement of the moral thinking abilities of students;
- f. appreciate the role of moral reasoning in developing good Filipino citizens and individuals; and
- g. articulate the value of moral reasoning in nation building.

The participants to this activity are teachers from public elementary and secondary schools.

A registration fee of One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP1,500.00) will be charged each participant inclusive of handouts and certificate.
