**YOUTH LENS 2010 FORUM**  
**(Does College Still Rock?: Career Decision-Making Among High School Students)**

The School of Education and Human Development (SED) of the University of Asia and the Pacific (UA &P) will hold a youth oriented forum entitled “Youth Lens: Does College Still Rock?: Career Decision-Making Among High School Students” on September 23-24, 2010 at the Telengtan Hall of University of Asia and the Pacific.

The forum will address concerns involving the issues in the career choices of today’s youth and their notion of college education.

Invited to attend the forum are two (2) high school students per school, specifically, high school student leaders preferably those in the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> year levels. A faculty adviser is also invited to participate in a separate workshop. Only the first sixty (60) students to make a reservation on or before September 6, 2010 (Monday) will be accommodated.

The conference fee for each student-participant is Eight Hundred Pesos (PhP800.00), inclusive of meals, the conference kit, and the certificate of participation. The faculty adviser will be charged a conference fee of One Thousand Two Hundred Pesos (PhP1,200.00). Advisers from public schools will be given a fifty percent (50%) discount; hence they will only pay Six Hundred Pesos (PhP600.00).
