**SEMINAR FOR TEACHERS ON HOW TO SPOT AND MANAGE DEPRESSION
AMONG CHILDREN AND TEENS WITH ATTENTION-DEFICIT
HYPERACTIVITY DISORDER (AD/HD)**

The Attention-Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (AD/HD) Society of the Philippines will hold the *Seminar for Teachers on How to Spot and Manage Depression among Children and Teens with AD/HD* on September 4, 2010 at the Walter Hogan Conference Center, ISO, Ateneo de Manila University, Quezon City.

The objectives of the seminar are to:

- a. enable the teachers and parents recognize the symptoms of the “syndrome mix”, like AD/HD co-existing with depression or bipolar conditions for the doctors’ identification of appropriate pharmacological treatments; and
- b. equip them with strategies to be used both at home and in the classroom in dealing with behavioral symptoms that may result from the interactions of these conditions.
