TABLE TENNIS ASSOCIATION OF THE PHILIPPINES (TATAP)
CERTIFIED UMPIRE COURSES

The Table Tennis Association of the Philippines (TATAP) under the auspices of the International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF) authorized the Table Tennis Association of the North District (TATAND) to hold the following courses:

1. Basic Certified Umpire Course Level I will be conducted on October 23-24, 2010 at the Green Paddle Table Tennis Training Center, 31 GPCC, 4th Avenue (between Teodoro and Del Mundo Sts.), Caloocan City, and the practicum on November 3-5, 2010 at the Multi-Purpose Arena (formerly Ultra), Philsports Complex (PSC), Meralco Avenue, Pasig City.

- Qualifications:**
- a. must be of good moral character;
 - b. must not be less than 18 years old; and
 - c. must be at least high school graduate.

Course Fee: Non-refundable: Six Thousand Pesos (PhP6,000.00) per participant, inclusive of seminar kits, snacks and lunch.

Deadline of Application: October 20, 2010

- Note:**
1. Certificates will be given to all participants; and
 2. Successful participants will automatically qualify to the Advanced Umpire Course (free-of-charge) to be held at the Multi-Purpose Arena. Billeting may be provided at the venue.

2. Advanced Certified Umpire Course Level II will be conducted on November 6-7, 2010 at the Multi-Purpose Arena.

- Qualifications:**
- a. must be of good moral character;
 - b. must not be less than 18 years old;
 - c. must be at least high school graduate;
 - d. must pass the Basic Umpire Course, or
 - e. must have at least two (2) years experience in umpiring the TATAP Tournaments.

Course Fee: Non-refundable: Five Thousand Pesos (PhP5,000.00) per participant, inclusive of lunch, snacks and seminar kits.

Deadline of Application: November 5, 2010

- Note:**
1. Certificates will be given to all participants;
 2. Successful applicants will be tapped to umpire at the 7th South East Asian Table Tennis Asian Championships to be held on December 12-15, 2010 in Manila and be allowed to umpire in all TATAP tournaments. Billeting may be provided to participants at the Multi-Purpose Arena; and
 3. Qualified participants may take the ITTF International Umpire's Examination after successful evaluation.
